Dressember is a global movement utilizing fashion and creativity to combat human trafficking from every angle. For the last 10 years, we have hosted a style challenge in December where people wear a dress or tie and fundraise for 31 days. Advocates raise critical awareness and funds for prevention, intervention, and survivor empowerment efforts in the ongoing fight against human trafficking around the world.



## THE DRESSEMBER COLLECTIVE

Since 2017, more than 500 Dressember Collective members have raised over \$323k, with an average monthly gift of \$36. This community provides the essential resources needed to protect vulnerable populations at risk of trafficking, offer an exit pathway for victims, and empower survivors year-round.

#### THINGS SURVIVORS WISH YOU KNEW

Historically, anti-trafficking advocacy has often relied on non-survivors' interpretations of survivors' experiences and needs. At Dressember, we're actively changing this by passing the mic to survivors. In 2022, we launched 'Things Survivors Wish You Knew,' a Dressember podcast that gives survivors the platform to share crucial insights on trafficking, exploitation, and the anti-trafficking sector.

## DRESSEMBER SURVIVOR SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

In 2021, we established the Dressember Survivor Scholarship Program to address a crucial survivor-identified need: access to education. To date, we've granted 18 flexible academic scholarships totaling ~\$80,000 to help survivors close the gap between physical freedom and long-term economic empowerment.
